WINGS operates resale stores in Niles, Palatine and Schaumburg. The success of the first two stores prompted the opening of a third location. The resale stores provide a significant amount of income for the agency which provides transitional and emergency housing and supportive services to women and their children who are victims of domestic violence or who would otherwise be homeless. In honor of the grand opening each WINGS resale store will offer specials and discounts the day of the celebration.

WINGS is a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) community agency whose mission is to provide a continuum of integrated services in an effort to end domestic violence and homelessness one family at a time. WINGS currently operates 24 homes and apartments throughout the north and northwest suburbs and in the city of Chicago.

These communities include Arlington Heights, Barrington, Des Plaines, Hoffman Estates, Mount Prospect, Palatine, Park Ridge, Rolling Meadows, Schaumburg, and Skokie. The Safe House, a 15,000 sq. ft. domestic violence emergency shelter, can house up to 45 women and children each night.

In addition to shelter, WINGS provides therapeutic counseling, mentoring, children's activities, career services, legal and medical advocacy and much more.
